Aerospace Lubricants expands in Columbus, adds high-quality jobs in advanced manufacturing

Expansion strengthens specialty lubricant production for aerospace, automotive and industrial markets

Columbus, Ohio — Aerospace Lubricants, a Columbus-founded manufacturer of high-performance synthetic lubricants used in automotive, aerospace and industrial applications, is expanding its operations in Columbus. The company will invest more than \$5 million to modernize its existing facility at 1600 Georgesville Road in Columbus, while retaining 37 existing positions and creating 15 new jobs.

The investment will support state-of-the-art mixing, blending and testing equipment designed to manufacture specialty greases used in high-temperature, high-stress environments, including aviation, defense and advanced industrial applications. The expansion allows the company to meet rising customer demand while continuing to develop new formulations.

“Aerospace Lubricants has a strong history of formulating products that perform in the most demanding conditions,” said Aerospace Lubricants President Dave Meyer. “This investment allows us to add new production capabilities and continue innovating from our Columbus headquarters. We’re excited to grow where our company was built and where we’ve found strong partners and a skilled workforce.”

Founded in 1973 and headquartered in Columbus, Aerospace Lubricants’ decision to reinvest locally reinforces Central Ohio’s role as a competitive location for advanced and specialty manufacturing.

“When an existing company doubles down and expands in place, it speaks volumes about the strength of the Columbus market. Aerospace Lubricants’ newest investment to expand operations in Columbus is a testament to how our region continues to deliver the workforce, infrastructure, and industry support for advanced manufacturing,” said Jason Hall, CEO of the Columbus Partnership. “As a critical supplier in the aerospace and defense industries,

Aerospace Lubricants' newest investment comes at an exciting time as those industries continue to cluster here in our region as well."

The company's investment adds to a wave of industrial growth across the Columbus Region. Recent manufacturing expansions include projects by Hims & Hers and Axium Packaging in New Albany, and Becker Mining Systems in Mount Vernon.

"This expansion is yet another proof point that Columbus is a magnet for growth, and meaningful progress for the families who call Columbus home," said Columbus Mayor Andrew J. Ginther. "The win brings economic security within reach for more residents and reflects the kind of steady investment that strengthens communities."

Hiring for the new positions is expected to begin in early 2026 and will include skilled production, technical and quality-focused roles.
